<b>Drinking water point</b>	Located at the front of the pub and marked with a W on the plan overleaf.
<b>Waste/toilet water disposal point</b>	Marked with an E on the plan overleaf.
<b>Rubbish</b>	You will be provided with a black bin liner to dispose of your rubbish in, which can be left in the skip at the front of the pub and is marked on the plan overleaf.
<b>First Aid</b>	We have resident First Aid assistance on site during Festival opening times. In the event of <b>AN EMERGENCY</b> (Note <b>EMERGENCY!</b> ) outside those times, please contact the steward responsible for night duties whose identity & contact details you can get from the notice board at the front of the Main Marquee
